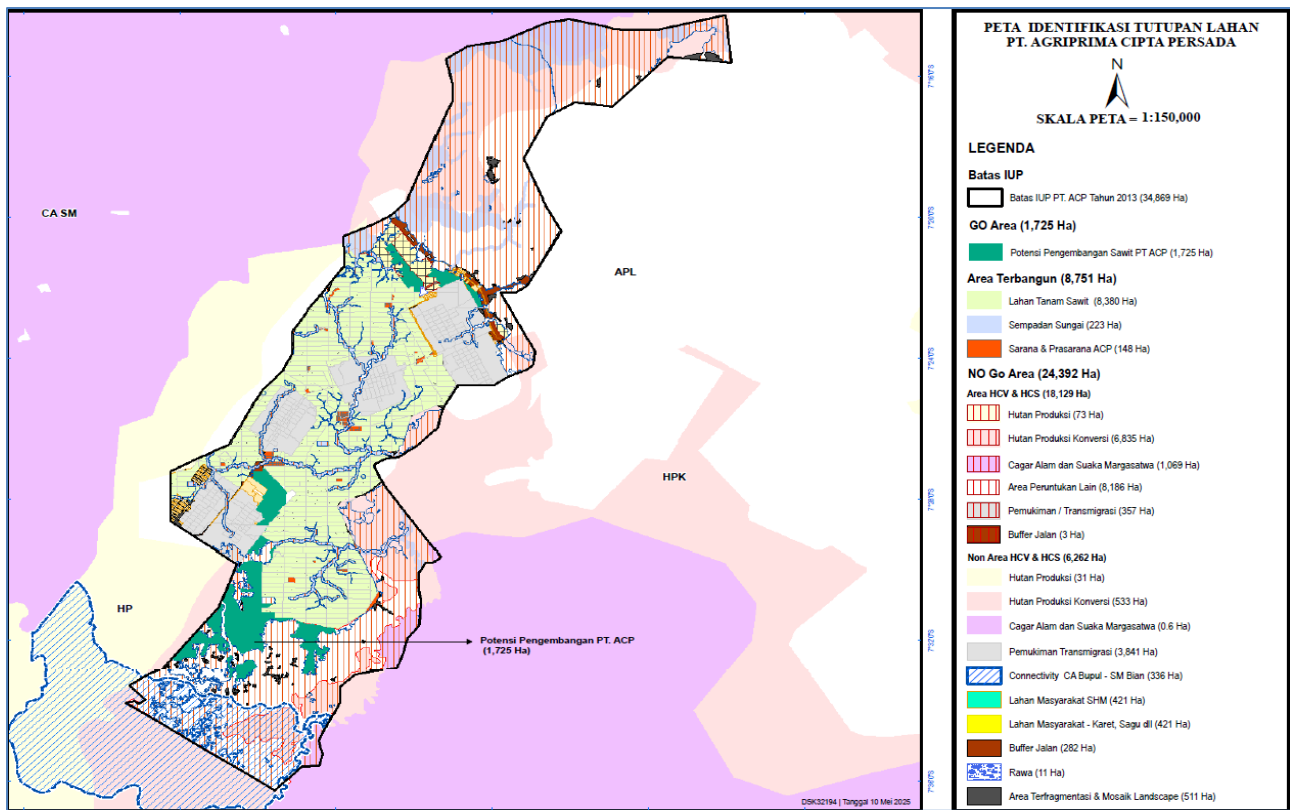

Summary

The verification was conducted in Merauke from 28 to 31 October 2025 by the Peterson Solutions Indonesia team and involved comprehensive data collection to establish reliable environmental and social baselines. The process combined a review of secondary data from government sources, previous studies, and spatial databases with field verification, including boundary checks, land-cover validation, conservation assessments, and structured interviews with local communities. This approach ensured that both biophysical and social conditions were accurately represented.



Referring to the HCV–HCS assessment and internal land-screening processes, an initial indicative development area was identified. Subsequent land-suitability analysis and participatory mapping confirmed that only 1,725.7 hectares are environmentally and socially suitable for development, while other areas are constrained by biophysical limitations, conservation values, or forest status. Given the difference between the legally released forest area and the environmentally feasible area, it is recommended that PT ACP report the development plan to the Ministry of Forestry, particularly the Directorate General of Forestry Planning and the Directorate General of Natural Resources and Ecosystem Conservation.

The verification confirms that the proposed new planting area lies entirely within PT ACP’s existing concession and remains consistent with the scope of the 2011 and 2020 AMDAL approvals. No significant environmental or social changes were identified, and the existing AMDAL framework, including RKL-RPL obligations, remains applicable. AMDAL Addendum should be prepared if minor discrepancies or new conditions are identified.

The assessment identified HCV 1–6 and HCS areas within the concession and confirmed the absence of peatland in the proposed development area, demonstrating alignment with the company’s peat-protection policy. Spatial analysis found no overlap between the proposed planting area and HCV zones, provided that strict planting exclusions and riparian buffers are maintained. LUCA analysis confirmed that no land conversion occurred between April 2009 and November 2023.

Participatory mapping and community consultations confirmed 1,725.7 hectares as suitable for new planting. The area proposed for development is situated on customary lands associated with four clans: Mahuze Elmeand, Mahuze Dayo, Zohe, and Ndiken Malindan. While most clans agreed to the proposed boundaries, three clans rejected development on their lands, which were subsequently excluded. At the same time, claims from clans outside the proposed area present potential social risks related to perceived inequity. To mitigate these risks, PT ACP should maintain transparent communication, clear land-selection criteria, and inclusive FPIC-based engagement. GRTT compensation has been completed for several areas, while approximately 719.9 hectares remain under active GRTT processing due to the involvement of multiple stakeholders. The completion of this process is essential to maintaining tenure clarity and community trust. Biophysical analysis shows that most of the 1,725-hectare area is suitable for oil palm development, with only limited areas requiring erosion-control measures. Land-use change projections indicate notable greenhouse gas emissions driven by land preparation, underscoring the need for careful mitigation planning to manage carbon impacts over the long term.

In summary, the proposed new planting area is technically feasible and broadly aligned with applicable sustainability standards and regulatory requirements. The New Development Planting Master Plan provides a general framework for implementation, supported by environmental and social assessments, participatory processes, and compliance with AMDAL, HCV–HCS, and LUCA requirements. Going forward, continued attention to environmental safeguards, social responsibilities, spatial conformity, and greenhouse-gas mitigation will be critical to supporting responsible land development, subject to ongoing review and compliance ([Click here for the report](#)).
